

Son leads us to contemplate the necessity of repentance in our relationship with God our Father.

The parable of the Prodigal Son (Luke 15:11-32) forms an exact icon of repentance at its different stages. Sin is exile, enslavement to strangers, hunger. Repentance is the return from exile to our true home; it is to receive back our inheritance and freedom in the Father's house. But repentance implies action: "I will rise up and go..." To repent

is not just to feel regret, but to make a decision and to act on it. In the words of our Lord, we also learn of three things through this parable: the condition of the sinner, the rule of repentance, and the greatness of God's compassion. The reading of this parable follows the Sunday of the Publican and the Pharisee so that, seeing in the person of the Prodigal Son our own sinful condition, we might come to our senses and return to God through repentance. For those who have fallen into great despair over their sins thinking that there is no forgiveness, this parable offers hope. The Heavenly Father is patiently and lovingly waiting for our return. There is no sin that can overcome His love for us.

PRAYER OF DAY: It is me, o Lord. I am the Prodigal. Grant me also a true spirit of repentance. Make me your true servant who accepts responsibility for my failings, and grant me the courage to face you and say, "Forgive me, for I have sinned". Grant that by my reception today of your Holy Mysteries, my repentance will be made perfect, and my reconciliation complete

A Reading of the First Epistle to the Corinthians (6:12-20): Brethren, 'All things are lawful for me', but not all things are beneficial. 'All things are lawful for me', but I will not be dominated by anything. 'Food is meant for the stomach and the stomach for food', and God will destroy both one and the other. The body is meant not for fornication but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body. And God raised the Lord and will also raise us by his power. Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? Should I therefore take the members of Christ and make them members of a prostitute? Never! Do you not know that whoever is united to a prostitute becomes one body with her? For it is said, 'The two shall be one flesh.' But anyone united to the Lord becomes one spirit with him. Shun fornication! Every sin that a person commits is outside the body; but the fornicator sins against the body itself. Or do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, which you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you were bought with a price; therefore glorify God in your body.

Gospel (Luke 15:11-32): The Lord spoke this parable: 'There was a man who had two sons. The younger of them said to his father, "Father, give me the share of the property that will belong to me." So he divided his property between them. A few days later the younger son gathered all he had and travelled to a distant country, and there he squandered his property in dissolute living. When he had spent everything, a severe famine took place throughout that country, and he began to be in need. So he went and hired himself out to one of the citizens of that country, who sent him to his fields to feed the pigs. He would gladly have filled himself with the pods that the pigs were eating; and no one gave him anything. But when he came to himself he said, "How many of my father's hired hands have bread enough and to spare, but here I am dying of hunger! I will get up and go to my father, and I will say to him, 'Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son; treat me like one of your hired hands." So he set off and went to his father. But while he was still far off, his father saw him and was filled with compassion; he ran and put his arms around him and kissed him. Then the son said to him, "Father, I have sinned against heaven and before you; I am no longer worthy to be called your son." But the father said to his slaves, "Quickly, bring out a robe—the best one—and put it on him; put a ring on his finger and sandals on his feet. And get the fatted calf and kill it, and let us eat and

But when this son of yours came back, who has devoured your property with prostitutes, you killed the fatted calf for him!" Then the father said to him, "Son, you are always with me, and all that is mine is yours. But we had to celebrate and rejoice, because this brother of yours was dead and has come to life; he was lost and has been found."



A JEALOUS HEART IS AN UGLY, TORMENTED HEART, POPE SAYS AT MORNING MASS

Jealousy and envy are ugly sins that grow like weeds in one's heart, Pope Francis said at the Mass. A heart that is envious is not only tormented, but can even "lead one to kill," the pope said Jan. 21 during the Mass in the chapel of Domus Sanctae Marthae.

The pope focused his homily on the day's first reading (1 Sm 18: 6-9; 19: 1-7) in which Saul plots to kill David out of jealousy for his growing fame. Although Saul heeded his son's advice to not murder David, the pope said, his jealousy returned like a "sickness" that opened the door to envy. "Envy is an ugly thing! It is an attitude, an ugly sin," he said. "And jealousy or envy grows in the heart like a bad weed: It grows, but does not let the grass grow." One who has an envious heart, he continued, cannot find peace and is tormented. The pope noted that because of Satan's envy, "death entered into the world." "Envy kills and it cannot tolerate that someone has something that I don't have," he said. "And he is always suffering because the heart of someone jealous or envious suffers. It is a suffering heart."

The pope called on Christians to pray for the grace to not open their "hearts to jealousy, to not open the heart to envy because these things always lead to death." Envy, he added, was also "the instrument" used by the high priests and scribes to deliver Jesus to Pontius Pilate and be put to death. "Let us also ask the Lord for the grace to never deliver to death a brother, a sister of the parish, of the community, not even a neighbor because of envy," Pope Francis said. "Each one has their sins, each one has their virtues; they are specific to each one. Look for the good and do not kill (others) with gossip out of envy or jealousy."

POPE TO WORLD ECONOMIC FORUM: 'DO NOT FORGET THE POOR!'

The Pope's cry for justice and integral development came in a message to the participants of the annual World Economic Forum taking place in Davos, Switzerland. Present among the over 2,500 participants for the 3-day event are over 1,000 chief executives or company chairs and more than 40 world leaders.

Your primary challenge – the Pope said to the movers and shakers of global economy today - is to "seek to help those poorer than yourselves to attain dignified living conditions, particularly through the development of their human, cultural, economic and social potential."

Emphasizing the fact that "we must never allow the culture of prosperity to deaden us, make us incapable of "feeling compassion at the outcry of the poor", he pointed out that "weeping for other people's pain does not only mean sharing in their sufferings, but also and above all realizing that our own actions are a cause of injustice and inequality".

In no uncertain terms Pope Francis tells business leaders to open their eyes, see the misery of the world, the wounds of our brothers and sisters who are denied their dignity, and recognize that we are compelled to heed their cry for help!"

And quoting from the Bull of Indiction of the Jubilee Year of Mercy he said: "May their cry become our own and together may we break down the barriers of indifference that too often reign supreme and mask our hypocrisy and egoism!"
